

Iraq in the Regional Indexes on VAWG and WPSA



Legal and gender experts from Federal Iraq and Kurdistan Region of Iraq (Iraq/KRI) met on 5th April 2023, in Erbil to discuss the Regional Index on Violence against Women and Girls (VAWG) and Women, Peace and Security Agenda (WPSA) and mechanisms to include Iraq.

Experts highlighted the importance of the Regional Index in documenting meaningful data to support informed decision-making and actions in combating VAWG and implementing WPSA in Iraq/KRI, underlining the continuum of VAWG in peace times and its exacerbation in times of armed conflicts. They discussed the scoring methodology as a tool meant to provide a global documentation and quick overview

that allows carrying out comparative studies on laws, public policies and services related to VAWG and WPSA and their alignment with international laws and women's rights instruments. Experts also focused on the methodology of work and agreed on the future steps both on national and regional level.

Iraq was the first country in the Middle East and North Africa (MENA) region to adopt in 2014 a National Action Plan (NAP) for United Nations Security Council Resolution (UNSCR) 1325 on women, peace and security, thus opening new opportunities for the promotion of women rights in the region.

Combating VAWG comprehensively and in its continuum, and supporting women's role and participation in decision making, conflict prevention, and peacebuilding is particularly relevant in Iraq, where more than one million people still need to be reintegrated into host or home communities.
